Junta leader Col. Mamadi Doumbouya said the military regime would not pursue vendettas against political enemies, though he also told officials from Conde's deposed government to turn over their passports.

"There will be no spirit of hatred or revenge. There will be no witch hunt," said Doumbouya, who had led the Guinean army's special forces unit before seizing power Sunday.

6 aircraft stuck in Afghan airport, no Taliban clearance to fly: Report

Washington: About 1,000 people, including Americans, have been stuck in Afghanistan for days awaiting clearance for their charter flights to leave, an organizer told Reuters, blaming the delay on the US State Department. The confusion was the latest flash-point following a chaotic US military withdrawal completed.
